DID YOU KNOW...

- **LEAD** is a poison that can be found in paint, dust & soil. **LEAD** poisoning can cause serious health problems in children & adults. **LEAD** paint is most likely present in homes & properties built before 1978.
 - This class teaches you how to use lead safe work practices and **recognize proper lead safe work techniques** that are required by the EPA for contractors, property managers, and landlords to use when working on your home or rental unit.
- THIS COURSE DOES NOT MEET RRP REQUIREMENTS FOR LANDLORDS OR PROPERTY MANAGERS.**

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

- **Home Owners** working on your **Primary Residence** and are concerned about lead hazards.
- Everyone is welcome to learn about Lead Safe Work Practices.
- If you were cited by the Health Department for **Lead Based Paint Violations** you are required to be **Certified** to Perform Lead Safe Work Practices.
- There is a **hands-on requirement** in order to receive **Certification to Perform Lead Safe Work Practices**.
- If you are unable to do the work yourself, we recommend that you **bring someone with you who can receive the certification and do the work**.
- Lead Primary staff will be on hand to help those who need to complete **WORK PLANS**.

There will be a 1/2 hr "lunch" break, Students can bring food to eat in the classroom or go out.

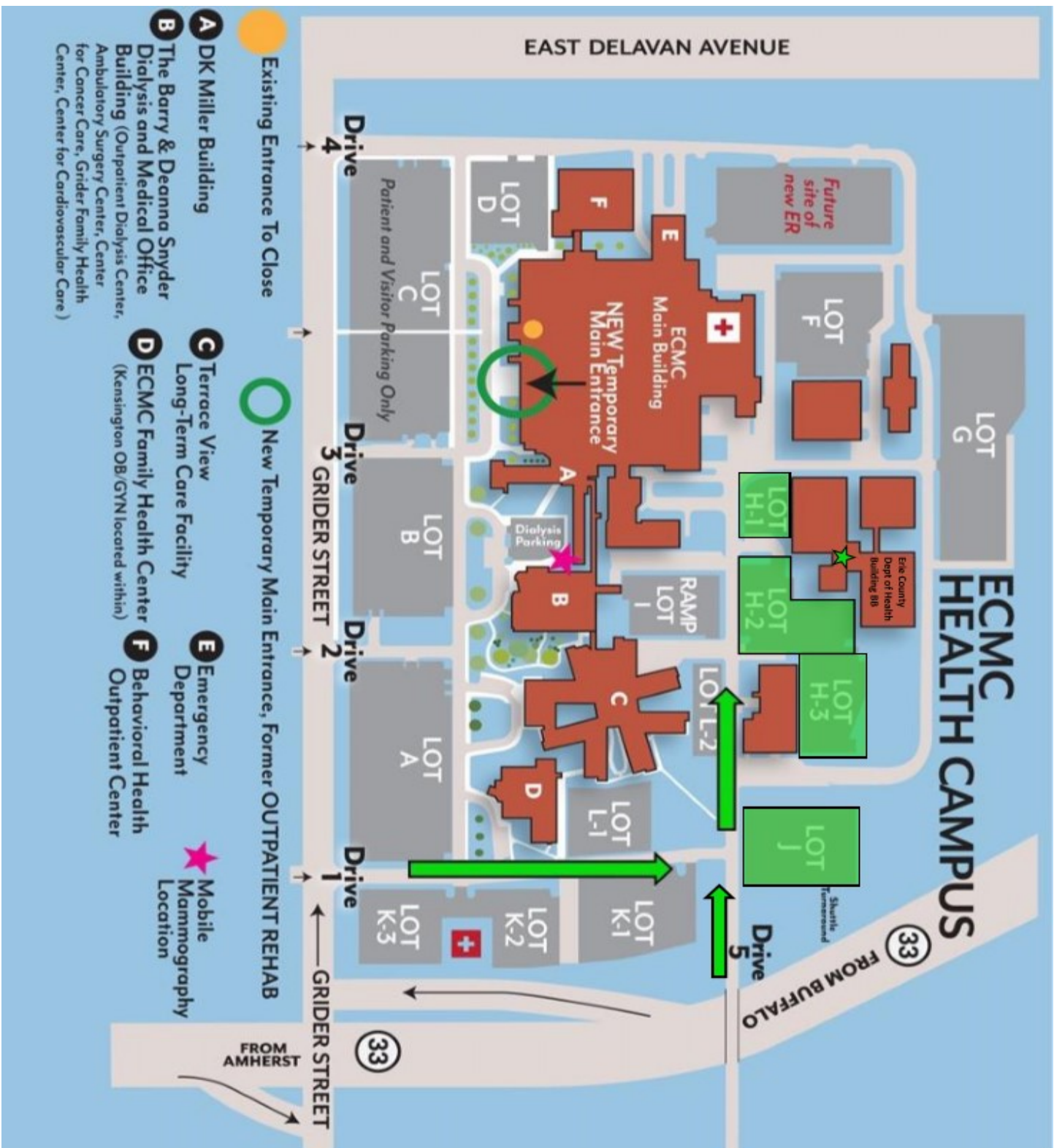
